### **PROXY VOTING**

#### **Congressional, Prosecutorial, State Senatorial, or State House of Representatives**

##### **District Executive Committee**

A member of a district executive committee may designate an active registered Democrat from his or her county or appropriate portion thereof to serve as his or her alternate for a particular district executive committee meeting by notifying the appropriate district executive committee chair or secretary of such designation in writing, prior to the call to order of such meeting; provided, however, that no person may serve as an alternate for more than one member at any meeting and no member can also serve at the same meeting as an alternate.
